How to pray


The Prophet Muhammad said:

(Sahih Al-Bukhari)

The obligatory prayers are: 2 Rak'at Fajr, 4 Rak'at Zuhr, 4 Rak'at 'Asr, 3 Rak'at Maghrib, 4 Rak'at 'Ishâ'.





Say Takbeer Tahrimah



Allâh is the Most Great.







Then start the prayer with this supplication:

اللَّهُمَّ! بَاعِدْ بَيْنِي وَبَيْنَ خَطَايَايَ كَمَا بَاعَدْتَ بَيْنَ الْمَشْرِقِ وَالْمَغْرِبِ، اللَّهُمَّ! نَقِّنِي مِنْ خَطَايَايَ كَمَا يُنَقَّى الثَّوْبُ الأَبْيَضُ مِنَ الدَّنَسِ، اللَّهُمَّ! اللَّهُمَّ! نَقِّنِي مِنْ خَطَايَايَ كَمَا يُنَقَّى الثَّوْبُ الأَبْيَضُ مِنَ الدَّنَسِ، اللَّهُمَّ! اللَّهُمَّ! اللَّهُمَّ! الْمَاءِ وَالثَّلْجِ وَالْبَرَدِ.





Then go into bowing (Ruku').




Say in the Ruku ':

(Recite it three or more odd times.)



After raising the head from Ruku', say:

سَمِعَ اللهُ لِمَنْ حَمِدَهُ


"Sami'-Allâhu liman hamidah"

Allâh hears those who praise him.



While going down to Sajdah say...



"Allâhu Akbar"

Allâh is the Most Great.

Then while prostrating say...


"Subhana Rabbiyal-a'la"

Glorified is my Lord, the Most High.

(Recite it three of more odd times.)



Place your hands down on the ground below your ears, and your forearms should not rest on the ground.




Your forehead along with the tip of your nose should touch the ground

During prostration seven parts of your body should touch the ground:



While rising to the sitting position say...




"Allâhu Akbar"

Allah is the Most Great.


Then sit up and say:

"Allâhummagh-firli warhamni wahdini wajburni wa 'âfini warzuqni warfa'ni."

O Allâh, forgive me and have mercy on me and guide me and hold me and heal me and provide sustenance for me and raise me up.




While going down in second prostration say...



"Allâhu Akbar"

Allah is the Most Great.

Then while prostrating say...




"Subhana Rabbiyal-a'la"


Glorified is my Lord, the Most High.

(Recite it three or more odd times)





And with the help of both hands, stand up for offering second *Rak'ah* saying *Takbeer*:






Begin Rak'ah with Sûrat Al-Fâtihah.

(It is obligatory to recite *Sûrat Al-Fâtihah* in every *Rak'ah*. Imam and the followers both have to recite it).

Alhamdu lillahi Rabbil-'alameen. Ar-Rahmanir-Raheem. Maliki yawmid-deen. Iyyaka na'budu wa iyyaka nasta'een. Ihdinas-siratal-mustaqeem. Siratal-ladheena an'amta 'alayhim ghayril-maghdoobi 'alayhim walad-dalleen." —Âmeen

In the Name of Allâh, the Most Gracious, the Most Merciful. All praise and thanks are Allâh's, the Lord of the 'Âlamîn. The Most Gracious, the Most Merciful. The Only Owner of the Day of Recompense. You (Alone) we worship, and You (Alone) we ask for help. Guide us to the Straight Way. "Bismil-lâhir-Rahmanir-Raheem. Inna a'tainakal-Kauthar. Fasalli lirabbika wanhar. Inna shani'aka huwal-'abtar."

In the Name of Allâh, the Most Gracious, the Most Merciful.

Verily, We have granted you Al-Kauthar (a river in Paradise). Therefore turn in prayer to your Lord and sacrifice (to Him Only). For he who hates you, he will be cut off (from prosperity in this world and in the Hereafter).

After this repeat the same (actions) in this second *Rak'ah* which you have performed in the first *Rak'ah*:

Saying

1. Takbeer (Allâhu Akbar)

Going into

2. Ruku (Bowing)

Standing upright into

3. *Qaumah* (Raising both hands up to your ear lobes or shoulders)

Going into first


4. Sajdah (Prostration)

Rising for

5. Jalsah (Sitting between two prostrations)

Going into second

6. Sajdah (Prostration)




After raising head from Sajdah, sit for Tashahhud and recite:

التَّحِيَّاتُ لِلهِ وَالصَّلَوَاتُ وَالطَّيِّبَاتُ السَّلَامُ عَلَيْكَ أَيْكَ أَيْكَ النَّبِيُّ وَرَحْمَةُ اللهِ وَبَرَكَاتُـهُ السَّلَامُ عَلَيْنَا وَعَلَىٰ عِبَادِاللهِ الصَّالِحِينَ. وَرَحْمَةُ اللهِ وَبَرَكَاتُـهُ السَّلَامُ عَلَيْنَا وَعَلَىٰ عِبَادِاللهِ الصَّالِحِينَ. أَشْهَدُ أَنْ لاَّ إِلهَ إِلاَ اللهُ وَأَشْهَدُ أَنَّ مُحَمَّدًا عَبَدُهُ وَرَسُولُهُ.

"At-tahiyatu lillâhi was-salawatu wat-tayyibatu as-salamu 'alayka, ayyuhan-nabiyyu wa rahmatullahi wa barakatuhu, as-salamu 'alayna wa 'ala 'ibadil-lahis-saliheen. Ashhadu alla ilaha illallâhu wa ashhadu anna Muhammadan abduhu wa Rasuluhu."

All the compliments, prayers and good things are due to Allâh. Peace be upon you, O Prophet and Allâh's Mercy and Blessing be on you. Peace be on us and on the true pious devotees of Allâh.

I testify that none has the right to be worshipped but Allâh and I testify that Muhammad is His slave and His Messenger.



(You can also recite other invocations beside this which are mentioned in the books of Ahadith).



While turning you head to the right say...

"As-salamu 'alaykum wa rahmatullâh"


Peace be upon you and the Mercy of Allâh.

Then turning your head to the left say...



Make Salutation first to the right and then to the left.



Importance of Salat (prayer)

1. The Prophet said: "Order your children to pray at the age of seven and beat them to do so at the age of ten and separate them (boys & girls) in their beds."

(Abu Daud and At-Tirmidhi)

2. The Prophet said: "Between a person and disbelief is the discarding of prayer."

(Muslim)

Imam Nawawi said while explaining this *Hadith*: The Prayer is like a barrier between *Kufr* (disbelief) and Islam, so whoever does not Perform prayer, he will enter in *Kufr* (he will be disbeliever).

Virtue of Prayer

The Prophet said:

"If there was a river at the door of anyone of you and he took a bath in it five times a day, would you notice any dirt on him?", They said, "Not a trace of dirt would be left." The Prophet said: "That is the example of the five prayers with which Allâh blots out evil deeds." (Sahih Al-Bukhari and Muslim)
